Itinerary

Day 1: Washington Junction to Cherryfield (26 miles)

- On the way we may ride to Donnell Pond for picnic lunch. (add 4 miles round trip for this)
- Stay the night at <u>Guagus River Inn</u>, Milbridge or <u>Englishman B&B</u> in Cherryfield.
- North Street Cafe can pack us lunches for the ride on Monday.
- Sandwiches and other food available at Mathews Grocery

Day 2: Cherryfield to Machias (27 miles)

- Stay at Machias Motor Inn
- Near Helen's Restaurant and Bluebird Ranch restaurant

Day 3: Machias to Dennysville (16 miles)

- Robinson's Cottages (16 miles) (add 3-4 miles if we take the side trip to Rocky Lake)
- Get subs in Machias to take with us or maybe some sort of sandwich from Helen's or the Bluebird Ranch. There is also a new little restaurant right on the trail about 6 miles out of Machias.
- Side trip to Rocky Lake for a picnic lunch. There is a new connection there to explore.

Day 4: Dennysville to Eastport (22 miles)
